**CALL FOR NOMINATIONS
TO THE INTERNATIONAL SOCIETY FOR SEXUALLY TRANSMITTED DISEASES RESEARCH
(ISSTDR) BOARD**

For more than 4 decades, the International Society for STD Research (ISSTDR) has been led the way in dissemination of research intended to reduce the burden of STD across the globe. This includes research in the areas of epidemiology, clinical & program practice, laboratory sciences and behavioral research. The ISSTDR Board is solely responsible for managing the meeting through selection of host locales and institutions and plays a major role in assuring the high quality of the research presented at this prestigious meeting. The ISSTDR Board invites nominations for membership of the Board to be considered at the Board meeting on 8 July 2017, just prior to the World STI & HIV Congress to be held in Rio de Janeiro, Brazil from 9-12 July 2017. There will be 4 positions open on the Board.

Successful applicants will have a strong track record in sexually transmitted infection research, including research leadership. Experience in working on conference committees will be an advantage but not essential.

A board member can expect to:

- Participate in the Board meetings held during ISSTDR/World Congress.
- Participate in telephone conferences when necessary between meetings.
- Work with the Congress leadership to assist with scientific content of the meetings as requested.
- Support and promote ISSTDR.

Nominations may be from a Board member or colleague, or an individual can self-nominate.

Applications should include:

- A letter from the nominee expressing reason for interest and qualifications for nomination.
- CV (maximum 4 pages) including a list of the most relevant publications.
- A single additional letter of support
